Play a podcast in the background to help manufacture the feeling of having other people around

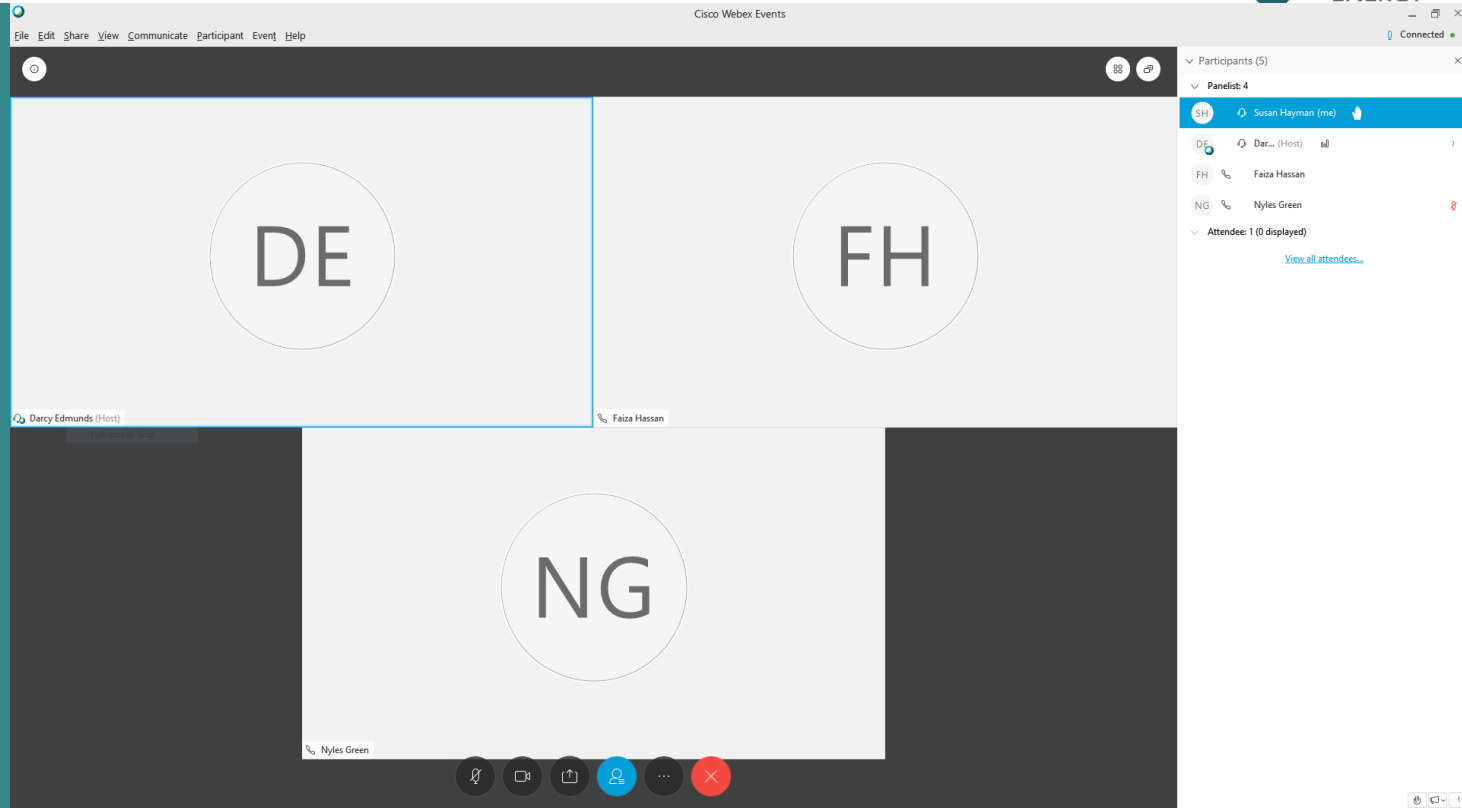
